Course Fee Payment Guidelines

1. The first-semester fee must be paid at the time of admission.
2. The consecutive semester fees must be paid within the dates specified by the institute.
3. Non - payment of the fees within the payment schedule will result in removal of student from the roll.
4. The fee is subject to revision.
5. No refunds will be provided under any circumstances.
6. In case of discontinuation of the course the current semester fee has to be paid by the PG student and the full course fee has to be paid by PGD student.
7. Students will bear all the other charges related to exams and other fee prescribed by the university separately.

Admission Guidelines

1. Applicants should fulfill all the eligibility requirements at the time of admission.
2. In the case of students awaiting their final results, their admission will be provisional.
3. All the details provided in the application form have to be correct and precise. No changes will be allowed after the submission of the application form.
4. Applicants must provide a valid phone number and email address. All communications will be made only through the number and email address provided in the application form.
5. Application fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
6. Once selected, the applicant must submit the original mark sheets, Transfer certificate, and Degree certificate at the time of admission failing which their admission will be cancelled.
7. Applicants who are awaiting the results of the qualifying examination at the time of application and who have not received their final year mark sheet / provisional certificate / Transfer certificate, as the case may be, should submit all such certificates mandatory for admission to the institute before the start of classes.
